### DAY 1 - WELCOME TO ISRAEL!!! TRAVEL TO TEL AVIV (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION) Sunday, January 19 2025

- **Welcome to Israel!!!** Arrive at Ben Gurion where you will be met by the tour guide, transportation
- Transfer to Tel Aviv
- Check into Hotel- settle in and relax
- Dinner at hotel (included)- **orientation and presentation** of the trip- Rabbi Rachel Ain Rabbi Dave Levy and our tour guide- David Keren

- **1:00 pm:** Volunteer at **Leket** sorting fruit and vegetables for the needy.
- Meet with the **Brothers in Arms organization** - to hear about their anti- Government activity and also their amazing operation since October 7th.
- Meet with columnist **Erel Segal**- (pro government) to hear about the view of the political unrest in Israel and how they see the future
- Dinner on own
- **Funny Monday Comedy Club**- cultural event in Tel Aviv- pending

## DAY 3 - TEL AVIV- TO JERUSALEM (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION) Tuesday, January 21 2025

---

- Full Israeli breakfast at hotel
- Speaker: **Inbal Elberg from the Nitzanim** project who have been assisting the evacuees and the Kibbutzim since October 7th
- Check out and depart
- **9:30 am:** Explore the vibrancy of Jewish Life & peoplehood at the ultra-modern, interactive **ANU Museum**
- Visit **Hostage Square** (hopefully not relevant) - and hear some of the stories behind some of the people still held by Hamas.
- Lunch on own at Sarona Market
- **2:00 pm:** Volunteer at **Soldiers Saves Lives**- a warehouse of donations
- Continue to Jerusalem
- **5:00 pm:** Dinner (included) and visit to the **Jewish Agency** - meet with **Yizhar Hess** , the Vice Chairman of the World Zionist Organization.
- Check in to hotel and settle in

## DAY 4 - VOLUNTEER- GAZA ENVELOPE (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION)

**Wednesday, January 22  
2025**

---

- **9:00 am:** Full Israeli breakfast at hotel
- Early departure to Gaza envelope to **volunteer working in agriculture** PREFERABLY EIN HABSOR. The agricultural industry has been hurt the most since October 7th (depending on the weather)
- **12:15 pm:** Lunch and meeting at **Ein Habsor with residents from the Moshav**
- **2:15 pm:** **Visit one of the Kibbutzim in the Gaza Envelope**- to bear witness to the atrocities from October 7th. Meet with one of the residents and hear the story of the Kibbutz. **Meet volunteers from ELUL** - who left their homes in Israel to devote time in rebuilding the south
- **4:00 pm:** Stop at the **Nova Festival site** - and see the placing that marked the place of the Massacre that happened there
- Return to Jerusalem
- Dinner on own

## DAY 5 - ISRAELI SOCIETY- JERUSALEM (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION)

Thursday, January 23 2025

- Full Israeli breakfast at hotel
- Visit **Nir Oz community** in their temporary residence in Kiryat Gat and hear from them the trauma they went through since October 7th
- Meet with **Mechina students from Meitarim Lachish** to hear about their experience and their hopes for the upcoming years in the Army
- Boxed lunch
- **3:30 pm:** Visit the impressive and grand new premises of the **National Library of Israel** which hosts the world's largest collections of Hebrew and Judaica books and is the repository of many rare and unique manuscripts, books and artifacts
- Dinner on own in Jerusalem
- **7:00 pm:** Watch the **Sound-&-Light Spectacular** screened on the walls of the **Tower of David**. (Show is outdoors. Please dress warmly & ensure to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start.)
